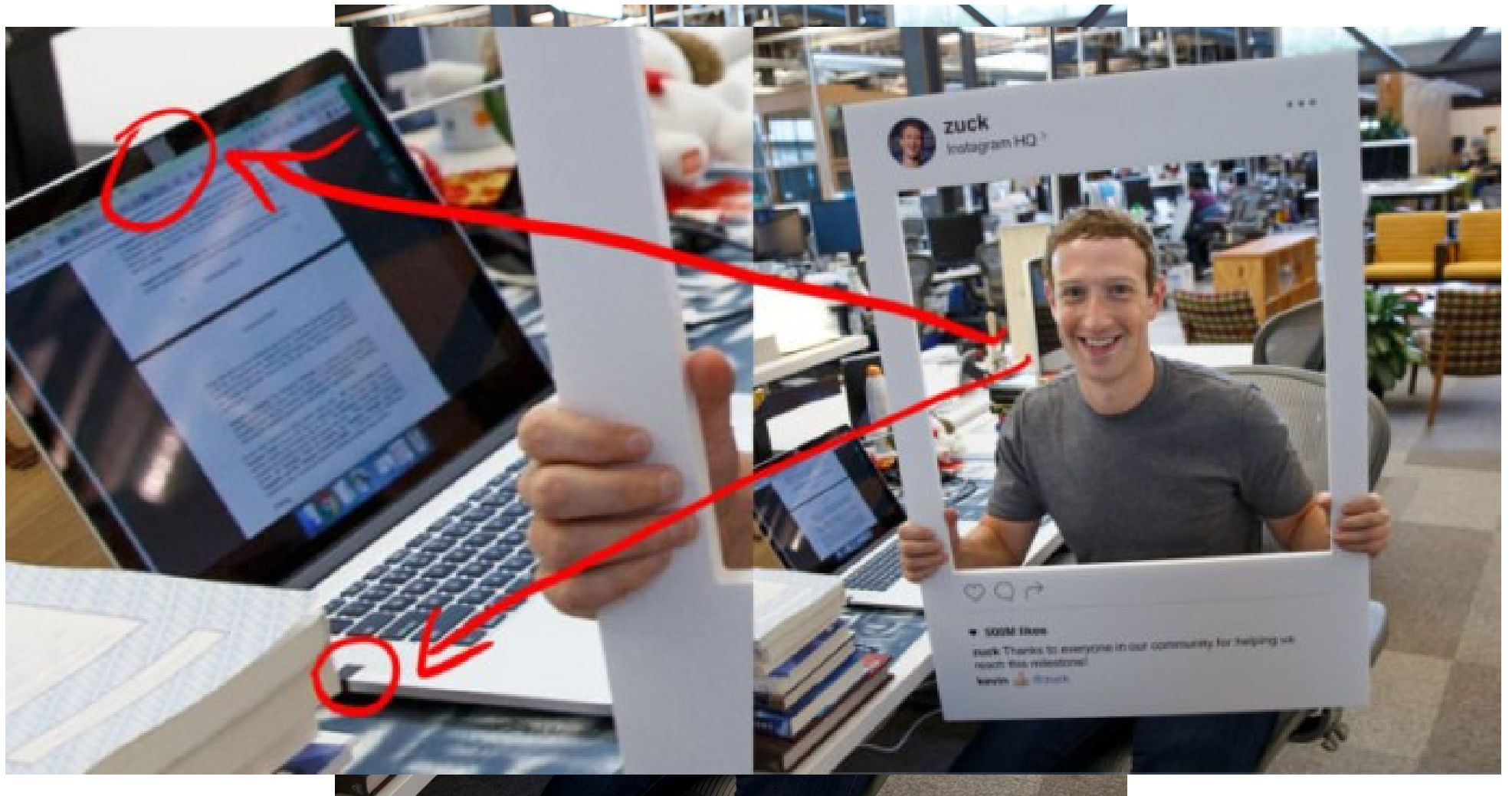

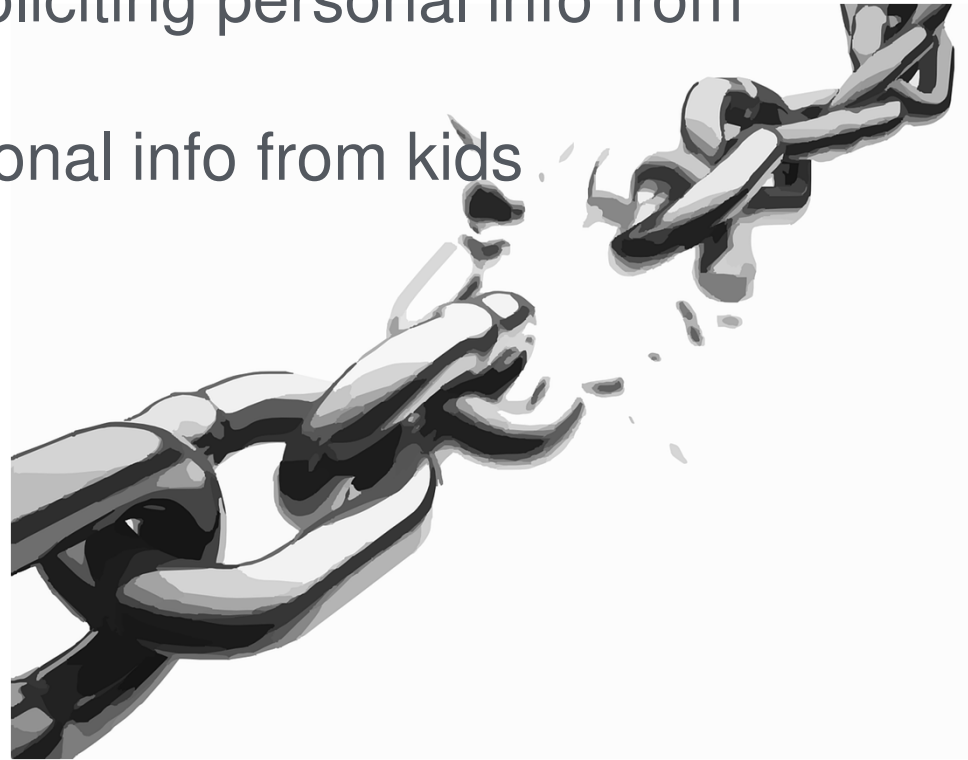

SOLUTIONS?

Legal Protections

Children's Online Privacy Protection Act "COPPA" requires that websites:

- Disclose privacy policies
- Get parental consent before soliciting personal info from kids
- Not retrieve unnecessary personal info from kids



Basic Tips

- Educate yourself—have some fun!
- Check phones for apps, privacy settings, browser history
- Set guidelines and rules (contract?)
- Use common areas
- Talk about dangers and consequences

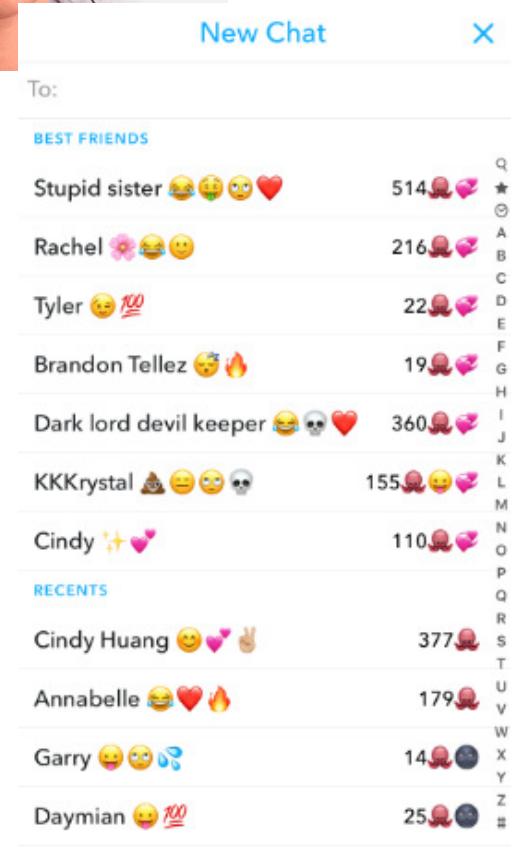
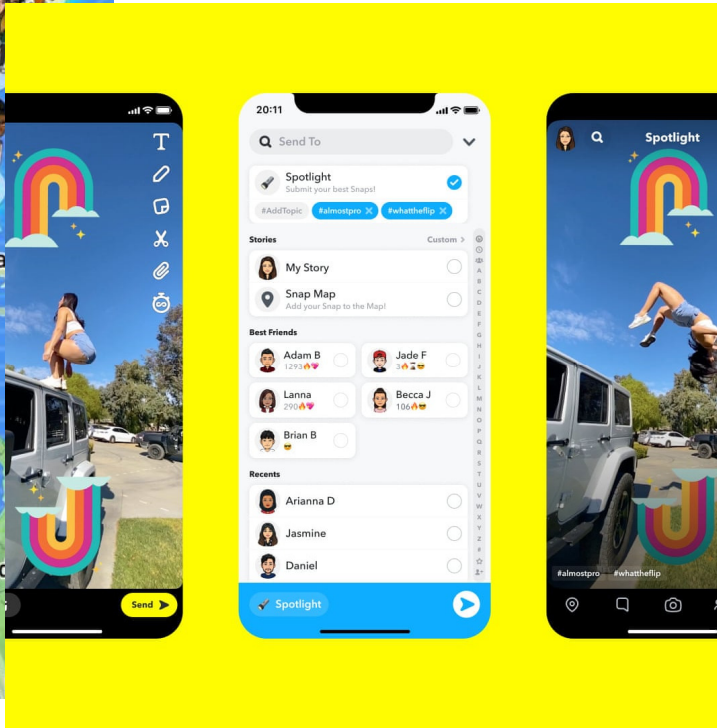
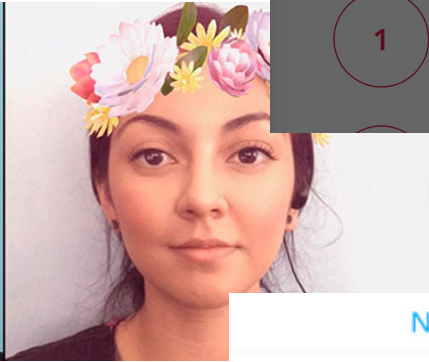
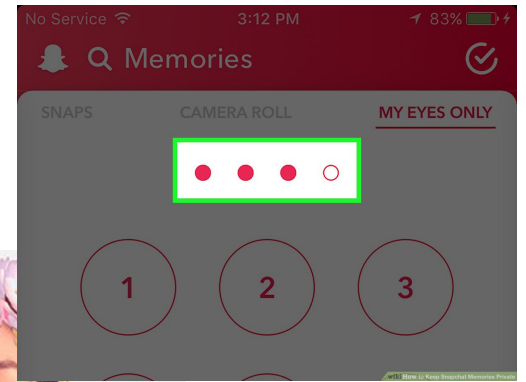
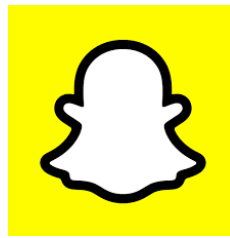
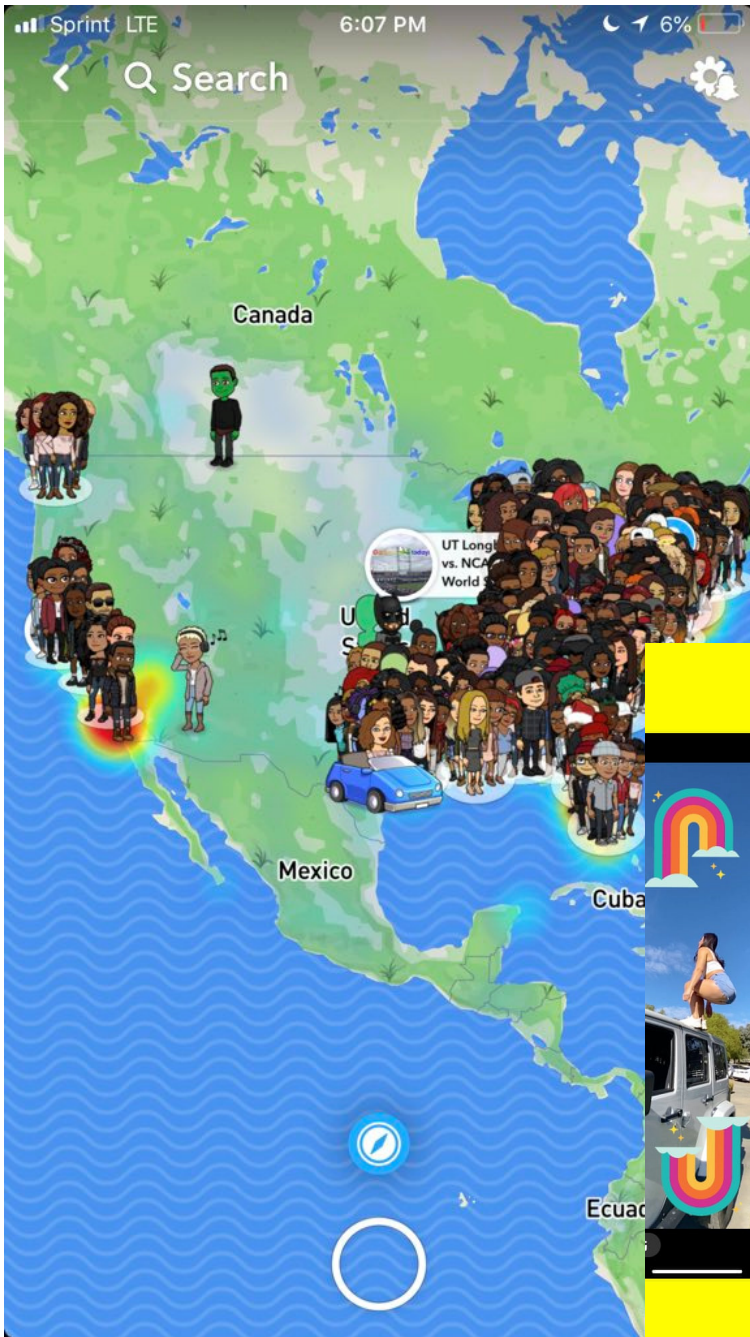


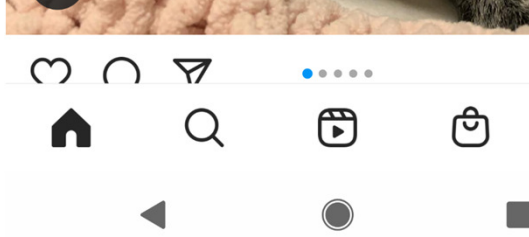
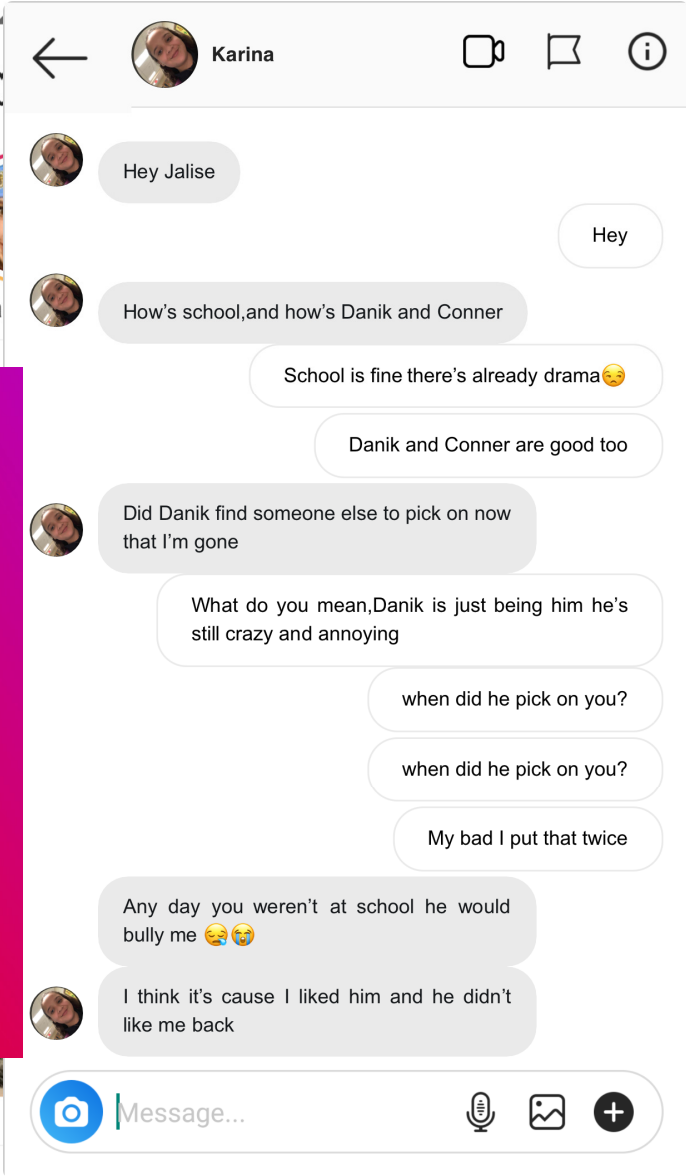
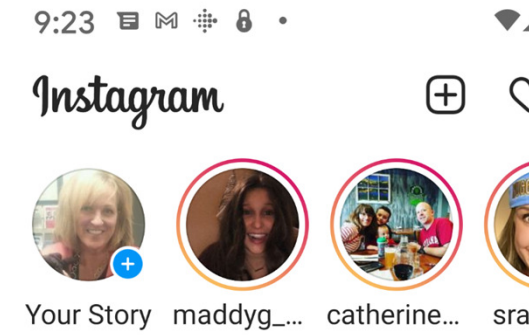

5. Tell!

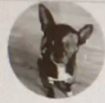

Juvenile Sexting

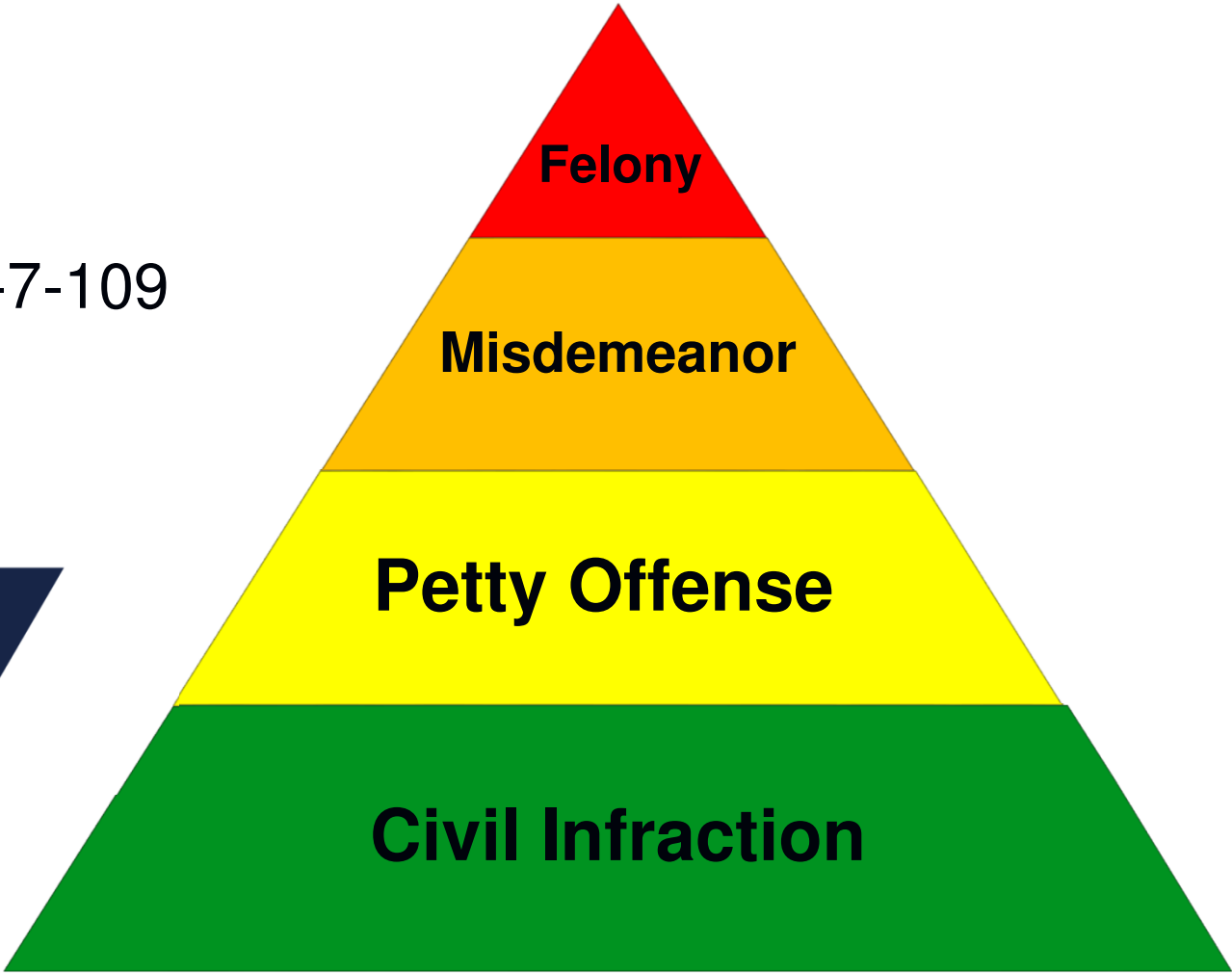
- Law changed in 2018

- Applies where juveniles (10 to 17) are

at least 14 years OR

within four years of age

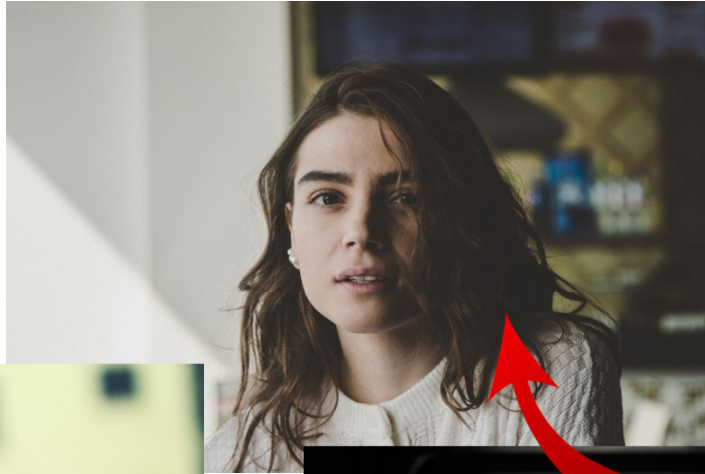

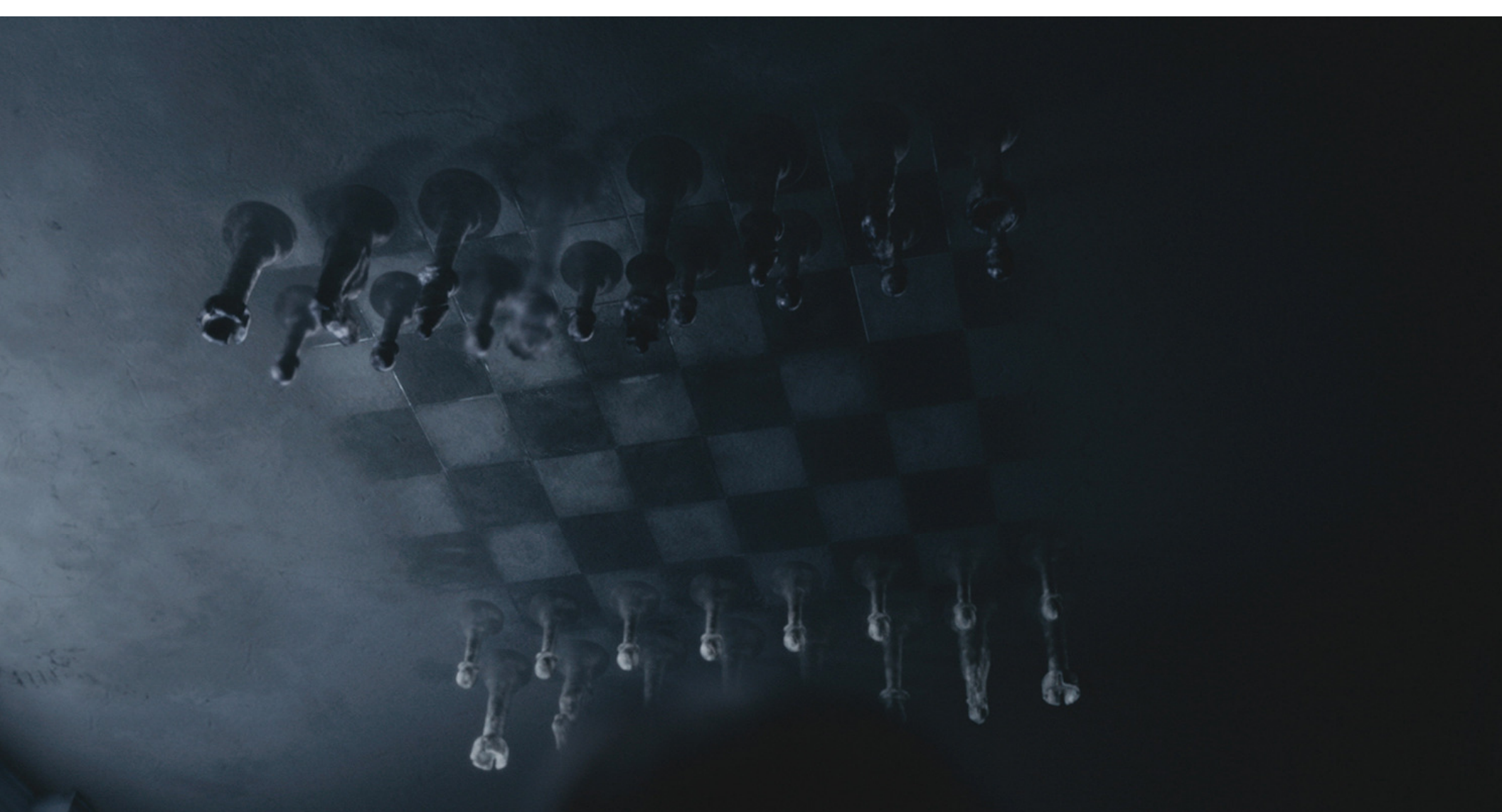

Bullying

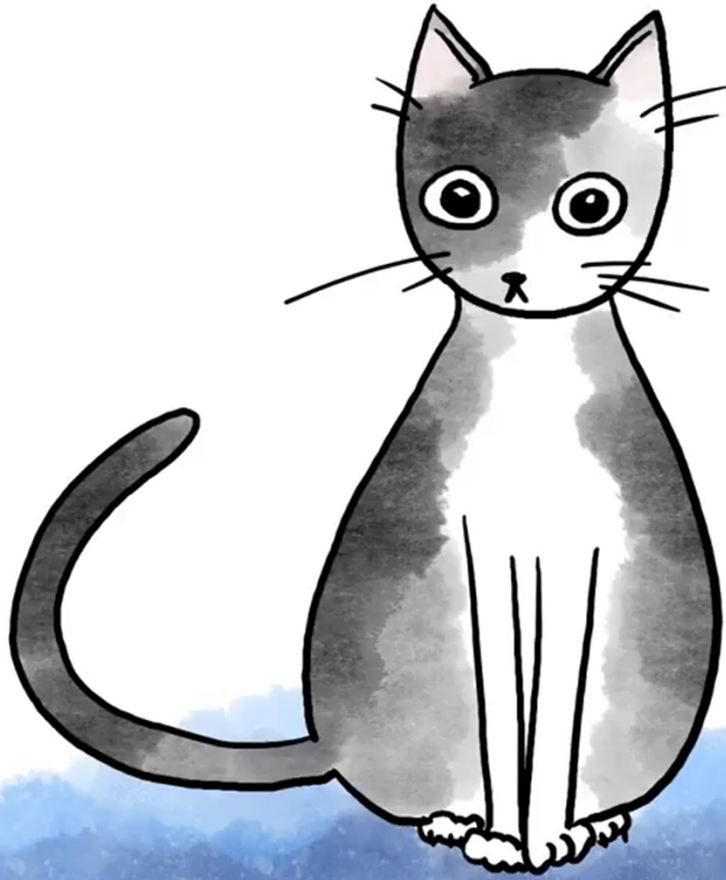
Bullying can occur

- ✓ At school (More students report being affected by bullying at school than bullying online.)
- ✓ At home
- ✓ Online


So the issue is *bullying*, not being online



Normal Conflict	Bullying
Equal power or friends	Imbalance of power; not friends
Happens occasionally	Repeated negative actions
Accidental	Purposeful
Generally not serious	Serious with threat of physical or emotional harm
Equal emotional reaction	Strong emotional reaction from victim and little or no emotional reaction from bully
Not seeking power or attention	Seeking power, control, or material things
Generally not trying to get something	May attempt to gain material things or power
Remorse - will take responsibility	No remorse - may blame victim

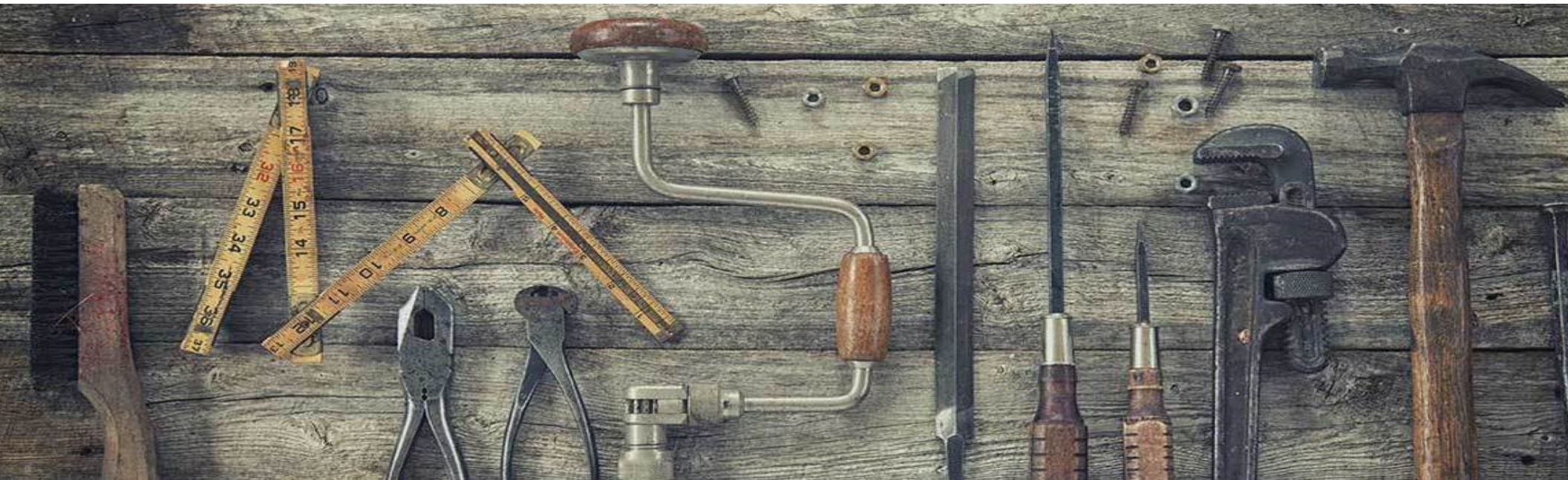
